### About Live Remote Captioning

One in every seven of the UK population experiences a hearing loss at some point in their life. For such people, using the telephone to make business calls can present particular problems.

Live Remote Captioning is a revolutionary new service which enables deaf and hard of people to fully access live meetings, teleconference calls and video conferencing using standard telephony.

A qualified captioner\* dials into your meeting or teleconference via Skype or telephone and listens to what is being said. Using specialist technology, the captioner then produces live subtitles of the conversation which are instantly streamed over the internet to any location in the world. The subtitles appear as scrolling text on any internet enabled laptop, desktop pc, BlackBerry, iPhone or iPod. You can then read the displayed text in real-time and respond directly to the other participants without anyone knowing you are receiving support.

Secure websites with password protection are used to prevent any breaches in security. You can scroll back to read any points you have missed or customise the text and background size and colour to suit your requirements.

### Who pays?

If you have a hearing loss, you will not usually be required to pay for communication support. Under the Equality Act 2010, it is the responsibility of the service provider to provide and pay for any "reasonable adjustments" you require.
